

Picture Chart Practice Sheet

This practice sheet may help you teach your child to recognize the same pictures that we show to children in our office when we measure their vision. Practicing at home before the next appointment may allow us to measure your child's vision even more accurately.

Sit with your child in a quiet place. Hold this sheet at a comfortable reading distance, so that your child can see the pictures. Using the larger pictures, teach your child to name the different pictures. It does not matter if your child calls the truck a "truck", a "car", or a "Jeep". After your child can name the larger pictures, you may then want to ask your child to try to name the smaller pictures. Finally, you may want to cover one of your child's eyes and ask him/her to name the pictures while looking with only the uncovered eye.
